Additionally, teachers have dormitory responsibilities and supervise extracurricular activities. We are looking for a teacher who is highly committed to our community and our mission and vision. Someone willing to go the extra mile and demonstrate flexibility and commitment. We are searching for a self-starter that is ready to be innovative and collaborative to help us build our program.
